A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HANALEI BAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Hanalei Bay is known 2 for its character as a quiet recreational area for families and 3 visitors to participate in ocean activities, including surfing, swimming, paddle boarding, sailing, and kayaking. 4 The 5 legislature further finds that there has been a growing increase 6 in the number of large vessels, including yachts and ships, 7 mooring in Hanalei Bay, posing a risk to the health and safety 8 of individuals and families participating in ocean activities in 9 the bay.

10 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to preserve the 11 quiet recreational character of Hanalei Bay and protect the 12 safety of residents and visitors who use the bay for water 13 activities by restricting the size of vessels permitted to enter 14 Hanalei Bay.

15 SECTION 2. Chapter 200, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 16 amended by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately 17 designated and to read as follows:

2	than seventy-five feet in length shall enter Hanalei Bay waters,

6	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
7	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
