A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TAXATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 62, Session Laws 2 of Hawaii 2023 (Act 62), provides, among other things, additional layers of protection against the rapid growth of the 3 use of electronic smoking devices among youth and young adults. 4 Act 62 also establishes the offense of unlawful shipment of 5 tobacco products, which was intended to close the existing 6 loophole in state law that allowed minors to purchase electronic 7 smoking devices on the Internet. However, the new offense of 8 unlawful shipment of tobacco products includes large cigars and 9 pipe tobacco, which has created unintended consequences for many 10 adult consumers in the State. The legislature notes that 11 12 federal law permits large cigars and pipe tobacco to be mailed via the United States Postal Service, unlike cigarettes and 13 electronic smoking devices. 14

15 The purpose of this Act is to exclude from the offense of 16 unlawful shipment of tobacco products the direct sale of large 17 cigars and pipe tobacco to adult consumers for personal use.
