
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREARMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 134-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (j) to read as follows:

3 "(j) Any person violating subsection (a) or (b) shall be
4 guilty of a class C felony; provided that any felon violating
5 subsection (b) shall be guilty of a class B felony~~[-]~~ and shall
6 be sentenced to an indeterminate term of imprisonment as
7 provided by law. Any person violating subsection (c), (d), (e),
8 (f), (g), or (h) shall be guilty of a misdemeanor."

9 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
