# H.B. NO. 181

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MEDIA.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Hawaii has unique 2 landscapes and natural environments that make it a very 3 desirable and popular film location. The world's filmmakers 4 come to Hawaii for universally tropical and natural locations under secure, familiar, and professional production 5 6 circumstances. The legislature further finds that in the past, 7 Hawaii has been known as "Hollywood's tropical backlot" due to 8 the number of high-profile films and television shows filmed in 9 Hawaii. As the most geographically isolated land mass on Earth, 10 Hawaii is home to eleven of the world's thirteen climate zones. 11 No other place offers more convenient, diverse, or magnificent 12 filming opportunities. Hawaii features an active volcano, 13 volcanic craters the size of Manhattan, snow-capped mountain 14 peaks, dense jungles, cattle ranches, the tallest sea cliffs, 15 and some of the best beaches in the world. As the film industry 16 continues to evolve and its technology continues to develop, the

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State needs to ensure that Hawaii and its beautiful, iconic 1 2 locations are protected and preserved. 3 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of 4 business, economic development, and tourism to fix the payment of royalties to the State for the filming of scenic shots of 5 6 iconic locations in the State that are subsequently featured in 7 media for production purposes. 8 SECTION 2. Chapter 201, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 9 amended by adding a new section to part IX to be appropriately 10 designated and to read as follows: 11 "**§201- Iconic location royalties.** (a) The department shall fix the payment of royalties to the State for the filming 12 13 of scenic shots of iconic locations in the State that are 14 subsequently featured in media for production purposes; provided that state and county productions shall be exempt from this 15 16 section. 17 (b) The department shall adopt rules pursuant to 18 chapter 91 for the purposes of this section, including: 19 (1) Establishing the basis upon which the amount and 20 duration of royalty payments to the State will be 21 fixed; and
