A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAIIAN LANGUAGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to part II, subpart B, to be 3 appropriately designated and to read as follows: 4 "\$302A- Hawaiian language; high school graduation 5 requirement. Each public high school in the State shall require 6 students to complete and pass two full years of Hawaiian 7 language courses as a condition of graduation, beginning with 8 the graduating class of ." 9 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored. 10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 11
