A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE SHRIMP.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that anchialine pools,
 also known as wai 'ōpae, are considered wahi pana, or culturally
 sacred, special ecosystems in Hawaii. Of the seven hundred
 recorded anchialine pools in the State, over six hundred fifty
 pools are located in the county of Hawaii, mostly in the
 districts of north and south Kona and Ka'ū.

7 The 'opae 'ula is a species of shrimp endemic to Hawaii's
8 anchialine pools. The population of 'opae 'ula is an important
9 indicator of the health of an anchialine pool. In healthy
10 anchialine pools, the population of 'opae 'ula is abundant.

11 The legislature further finds that the designation of the 12 'opae 'ula as the state shrimp will raise awareness of the 'opae 13 'ula and support efforts to protect anchialine pool ecosystems 14 throughout the State as a natural resource. In designating the 15 'opae 'ula as the state shrimp, the legislature does not intend

1	to prevent or impact the traditional and ongoing practice of
2	harvesting 'ōpae to be used in 'ōpelu fishing.
3	Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to establish 'ōpae
4	'ula as the state shrimp.
5	SECTION 2. Chapter 5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
6	by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
7	read as follows:
8	" <u>§5-</u> State shrimp. The 'ōpae 'ula (Halocaridina rubra),
9	also known as the red shrimp, is established and designated as
10	the official shrimp of the State."
11	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
12	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
