A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CANNABIS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 328J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is			
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated				
3	and to read as follows:				
4	" <u>§32</u>	8J- Cannabis; prohibitions. Smoking of cannabis			
5	shall be	prohibited in any area accessible by the public,			
6	including	but not limited to:			
7	(1)	On any school grounds;			
8	(2)	At any public park, public beach, public recreation			
9		center, recreation or youth center;			
10	(3)	In or on any land, facility, building, or vehicle			
11		owned, controlled, or operated by the State or any			
12		county;			
13	(4)	In or on any federal fort or arsenal, national park or			
14		forest, any other federal enclave, or any other			
15		property owned, controlled, or operated by the federal			
16		government; or			

1 (5) Any other place where smoking is prohibited by this 2 chapter." SECTION 2. Section 328J-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 3 4 amended as follows: 5 1. By adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted 6 and to read: 7 ""Cannabis" shall have the same meaning as in section 329-8 121." 2. By amending the definition of "smoke" or "smoking" to 9 10 read: 11 ""Smoke" or "smoking" means inhaling, exhaling, burning, or 12 carrying any lighted or heated tobacco product, cannabis, or 13 plant product intended for inhalation in any manner or in any 14 form. "Smoking" includes the use of an electronic smoking 15 device." 16 SECTION 3. Section 329-122, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is **17** amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows: 18 "(e) The authorization for the medical use of cannabis in 19 this section shall not apply to: (1) The medical use of cannabis that endangers the health 20 21 or well-being of another person;

2		(A)	In a school bus, public bus, or any moving
3			vehicle;
4		(B)	In the workplace of one's employment;
5		(C)	On any school grounds;
6		(D)	At any public park, public beach, public

9			that a qualifying patient, primary caregiver,
10			qualifying out-of-state patient, caregiver of a
11			qualifying out-of-state patient, or an owner or
12			employee of a medical cannabis dispensary
13			licensed under chapter 329D shall not be
14			prohibited from transporting cannabis or any
15			manufactured cannabis product, as that term is
16			defined in section 329D-1, in any public place;
17			provided further that the cannabis or
18			manufactured cannabis product shall be
19			transported in a sealed container, not be visible
20			to the public, and shall not be removed from its

3	(3)	The use of cannabis by a qualifying patient, parent,			
4		primary caregiver, qualifying out-of-state patient, or			
5		caregiver of a qualifying out-of-state patient, for			
6		purposes other than medical use permitted by this			
7		part[+]; and			
8	(4)	Smoking cannabis in public, including through the use			
9		of an electronic smoking device, as prohibited by			
10		section 328J"

Cannabis; Cannabis for Medical Use; Smoking; Prohibitions; Public Places

Description:

Prohibits the smoking of cannabis and the smoking of cannabis for medical use, including via an electronic smoking device, in any area accessible by the public.

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
