## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TAXATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 62, Session Laws 2 of Hawaii 2023 (Act 62), provides, among other things, 3 additional layers of protection against the rapid growth of the use of electronic smoking devices among youth and young adults. 4 Act 62 also establishes the offense of unlawful shipment of 5 6 tobacco products, which was intended to close the existing loophole in state law that allowed minors to purchase electronic 8 smoking devices on the Internet. However, the new offense of 9 unlawful shipment of tobacco products includes large cigars, 10 which has created unintended consequences for many adult 11 consumers in the State. The legislature notes that federal law 12 permits large cigars to be mailed via the United States Postal 13 Service, unlike cigarettes and electronic smoking devices. 14 The purpose of this Act is to exclude from the offense of

unlawful shipment of tobacco products the direct sale of large

cigars to adult consumers for personal use.
