
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that out of the two
2 hundred fifty-eight public elementary, middle, intermediate, and
3 high schools throughout the State, only seventy-five schools
4 have a full-time or part-time librarian position filled to
5 support student learning in 2025.

6 The purpose of this Act is to:

- 7 (1) Establish a two-year pilot program for certified
8 librarians to provide rotating support services to
9 schools in one school complex on Oahu and one school
10 complex on a neighbor island; and
11 (2) Appropriate funds for the positions.

12 SECTION 2. (a) There is established within the department
13 of education a two-year pilot program for certified
14 librarians to provide rotating support services to one school
15 complex on Oahu and one school complex on a neighbor island.
16 The department of education shall determine which school
17 complexes shall be part of the pilot program.



1 (b) The department of education shall submit a report to
 2 the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening
 3 of the regular sessions of 2026 and 2027. Each report shall
 4 include findings and recommendations, including any proposed
 5 legislation, about the pilot project established pursuant to
 6 subsection (a). The report submitted prior to the convening of
 7 the regular session of 2027 shall make a recommendation as to
 8 whether the pilot project should be extended.

9 (c) The pilot program shall cease to exist on June 30,
 10 2027.

11 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
 13 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
 14 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
 15 year 2026-2027 for the establishment of twelve-month state
 16 office-level teacher positions under the department of education
 17 for the pilot program established pursuant to section 2 of this
 18 Act; provided that the funds appropriated shall be allocated as
 19 follows:



1 (1) \$ for twelve-month state office-level
2 teacher position, to be filled by a certified
3 librarian, for a school complex on Oahu; and

4 (2) \$ for twelve-month state office-level
5 teacher position, to be filled by a certified
6 librarian, for a school complex on a neighbor island.

7 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
8 of education for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
