### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CLIMATE EDUCATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that in response to the 2 growing threat of climate change, the State has set standards 3 and launched initiatives to expand reliance on sustainable and 4 efficient energy, including setting a statewide benchmark of 5 generating one hundred per cent of the State's electricity through renewable resources by 2045 and establishing a goal for 6 7 statewide greenhouse gas emissions to be at least fifty per cent 8 below 2005 levels by 2030. 9 The legislature further finds that climate change education 10 is necessary to ensure that the next generation are climate 11 leaders. In 2024, Colorado enacted a law to award a seal of 12 climate literacy diploma endorsement to students who complete certain courses and an experiential learning project. 13 14 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of 15 education to establish a climate literacy certificate program to 16 provide students with an advanced understanding of climate

change through academic coursework and hands-on learning.
