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# HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO  
CONVENE A WORKING GROUP TO ASSESS ENVIRONMENTAL AND  
CONSERVATION INITIATIVES NEEDED TO TRANSITION VOLCANO,  
HAWAII, INTO A BIOSPHERE AREA THAT PROMOTES ENVIRONMENTAL  
SUSTAINABILITY AND COMMUNITY WELL-BEING AND COMPLEMENTS THE  
NEIGHBORING HAWAIIAN ISLANDS BIOSPHERE RESERVE.

1           WHEREAS, the Hawaiian Islands Biosphere Reserve was a  
2 United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization  
3 (UNESCO) biosphere reserve that was comprised of Hawaii  
4 Volcanoes National Park and Haleakala National Park; and

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6           WHEREAS, UNESCO biosphere reserves are recognized for their  
7 commitment to balancing human activity with environmental  
8 conservation and sustainable development; and

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10           WHEREAS, to become a UNESCO biosphere reserve, an area must  
11 be nominated by its national government and meet certain  
12 criteria related to conservation, sustainable development, and  
13 scientific research; and

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15           WHEREAS, although Hawaii Volcanoes National Park met these  
16 high environmental and conservation standards, the greater  
17 Volcano, Hawaii, area suffers from many issues that threaten its  
18 environment and natural resources; and

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20           WHEREAS, Volcano, Hawaii, has been subject to invasive  
21 plant species, Rapid Ohia Death, ungulates, declining native  
22 plant populations, and forest loss and degradation; and

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24           WHEREAS, Volcano, Hawaii, should adopt similar  
25 environmental and conservation initiatives as Hawaii Volcanoes  
26 National Park; now, therefore,

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28           BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
29 Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session



1 of 2025, that the Department of Land and Natural Resources is  
2 requested to convene a working group to assess environmental and  
3 conservation initiatives needed to transition Volcano, Hawaii,  
4 into a biosphere area that promotes environmental sustainability  
5 and community well-being and complements the neighboring  
6 Hawaiian Islands Biosphere Reserve; and

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group is requested  
9 to consist of the following individuals:

11 (1) The State Representative from House District 5, who  
12 shall serve as Chair of the working group; and  
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14 (2) A representative from the Volcano Community  
15 Association, to be invited by the Chair of the working  
16 group; and

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group is requested  
19 to:

21 (1) Conduct a literature review that assesses existing  
22 reports and studies that provide insight into the  
23 environment, natural resources, and socioeconomic  
24 conditions of Volcano, Hawaii;  
25  
26 (2) Develop best practices for native ohia forest  
27 stewardship that inform sustainable development, land  
28 use, green infrastructure development, and water  
29 resource management;  
30  
31 (3) Develop a community engagement strategy that increases  
32 education and awareness of environmental issues in  
33 Volcano, Hawaii;

35 (4) Develop a monitoring and evaluation system that tracks  
36 the progress of environmental and conservation  
37 initiatives in Volcano, Hawaii; and  
38  
39 (5) Identify potential buffer zones and conservation  
40 easements for activities that support ohia forest  
41 preservation and sustainable development; and

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group is requested  
2 to determine the scope of the actions and initiatives to be  
3 conducted in the biosphere area; and  
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5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group is requested  
6 to submit a report of its findings and recommendations,  
7 including any proposed legislation, to the Legislature and the  
8 Hawaii County Council no later than twenty days prior to the  
9 convening of the Regular Session of 2026; and  
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11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Land and  
12 Natural Resources is requested to provide any necessary  
13 administrative support to the working group, including the  
14 preparation and drafting of the report; and  
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16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group shall cease  
17 to exist on June 30, 2026; and  
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19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this  
20 Resolution be transmitted to the President of the Volcano  
21 Community Association Board of Directors.
