BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to implement the
- 2 recommendations of the Hawaii low-income home energy assistance
- 3 program working group.

- 4 SECTION 2. Chapter 269, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 5 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
- 6 designated and to read as follows:
- 7 "§269- Hawaii low-income home energy assistance program
- 8 surcharge. The public utilities commission, by order or rule,
- 9 shall require that not more than per cent of the moneys
- 10 collected by Hawaii's electric utilities from their ratepayers
- 11 through a demand-side management surcharge be transferred to the
- 12 commission for deposit into the Hawaii low-income home energy
- 13 assistance program special fund established pursuant to section
- 14 <u>346-B.</u>"
- 15 SECTION 3. Chapter 346, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended by adding two new sections to be appropriately
- 17 designated and to read as follows:

1	SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the Hawaii
2	low-income home energy assistance program special fund the sum
3	of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
4	year 2025-2026 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be
5	necessary for fiscal year 2026-2027 for the Hawaii low-income
6	home energy assistance program.
7	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
8	of human services for the purposes of this Act.
9	SECTION 6. In codifying the new sections added by
10	section 3 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute
11	appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating
12	the new sections in this Act.
13	SECTION 7. New statutory material is underscored.
14	SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect on July 1 , 2025.
