### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:


SECTION 1. The legislature finds that illegal use,
possession, and distribution of fireworks continue to endanger
public safety, property, and the environment in the State.
Despite existing laws and enforcement efforts, unauthorized
fireworks persist, causing disturbances and posing significant
risks to residents.

7 On June 7, 2023, the governor signed Act 67, Session Laws 8 of Hawaii 2023, into law, establishing an illegal fireworks task force within the department of law enforcement. The illegal 9 10 fireworks task force was required to develop a comprehensive 11 strategic plan to address the systemic problem of illegal 12 firework trade and usage within the State. The illegal 13 fireworks task force submitted a final report to the thirtythird legislature containing the task force's findings, 14 recommendations, and proposed legislation, which included a 15 recommendation that the legislature fund a new crime unit within 16

1	the department of law enforcement to address illegal fireworks
2	enforcement on a full-time basis.
3	Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to establish an
4	illegal fireworks enforcement division within the department of
5	law enforcement to enhance regulatory oversight, increase
6	enforcement, and further coordination among agencies to combat
7	illegal fireworks activities.
8	SECTION 2. Chapter 353C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

4	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
5	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
6	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
7	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
8	year 2026-2027 to carry out the purposes of this Act, including
9	the operation of the fireworks enforcement division,
10	reimbursement of funds to law enforcement agencies for division-
11	related law enforcement operations, including law enforcement
12	personnel, overtime and other salary-related payments, charges
13	for fuel, equipment, technology, and storage and disposal of
14	confiscated fireworks.
15	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
16	of law enforcement for the purposes of this Act.
17	SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
18	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
19	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
20	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
21	year 2026-2027 for the establishment of six permanent positions

within the illegal fireworks enforcement division of the
department of law enforcement as follows:
(1) One full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) division
administrator position;
(2) Four full-time equivalent (4.0 FTE) state law
enforcement investigator positions; and
(3) One full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) clerk
position,
Who shall be exempt from chapter 76, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department of law
enforcement for the purposes of this Act.
SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored.
SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025, and
shall be repealed on June 30, 2028.
