A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WATER POLLUTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 342D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- "§342D- Recycled water; requirement. By January 1, 4
- 5 2045, no less than fifty per cent of treatment works effluent
- shall be recycled water classified as R-1 and that is suitable 6
- 7 for use in recycled water systems."
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 342D-50.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 9 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 10 Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, no "(a)
- 11 person, including any public body, shall discharge any treated
- 12 or raw sewage into state waters after December 31, [2026;] 2030;
- 13 provided that this section shall not apply to a sewage treatment
- plant that: 14
- 15 (1) Utilizes sewage to produce clean energy pursuant to
- 16 section 196-10.5[+] and has primary and secondary

1	outfalls; provided that the primary outfall shall not
2	be located in state waters; and
3	(2) Is in compliance with this chapter, rules adopted
4	pursuant to this chapter, or a permit or variance
5	issued by the director."
6	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
7	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
8	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Water Pollution; Wastewater; Sewage; Recycled Water; Treatment

Description:

Requires at least fifty per cent of treatment works effluent to be R-1 recycled water by January 1, 2045. Amends the year by which no treated or raw sewage shall be discharged into state waters.
