A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PARKING FOR DISABLED PERSONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that parking spaces
- 2 reserved for persons with disabilities are vital for ensuring
- 3 that public and private places remain accessible to everyone in
- 4 our community. When persons who are not entitled to use these
- 5 reserved spaces park in them nonetheless, they put that
- 6 accessibility at risk.
- 7 The legislature further finds that when a person illegally
- 8 parks in a parking space for persons with disabilities, that
- 9 person often does so because they do not understand the rules
- 10 surrounding these spaces, or because they do not believe they
- 11 will be caught for doing so, or both.
- Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to enable those who
- 13 are entitled to park in spaces for persons with disabilities to
- 14 report violations when they see them, and for the State to use
- 15 those reports to educate violators about the law and penalties
- 16 and deter future violations.

1 SECTION 2. Section 291-57, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "\$291-57 Parking spaces reserved for persons with 4 disabilities; penalties[-]; citizen reporting. (a) Any person 5 who uses a parking space reserved for persons with disabilities 6 who: 7 Fails to properly display a disability parking permit; (1) 8 Displays an invalid disability parking permit; (2) 9 (3) Uses a disability parking permit that was not issued 10 to that person or to any passengers occupying the vehicle in the parking space; or 11 With or without a disability parking permit: 12 (4) 13 Parks in an access aisle; or (A) 14 Obstructs the ingress or egress to a parking (B) 15 space reserved for a person with a disability; shall be quilty of a traffic infraction under chapter 291D and 16 shall be fined no less than \$250 nor more than \$500 and pay any 17 costs incurred by the court related to assessing the fine; 18 provided that a person with a disability who has been issued a 19 20 valid disability parking permit that is currently in effect, and 21 who has failed to display the disability parking permit while

2	pay a fine of no less than \$25 nor more than \$100 and any costs
3	incurred by the court related to assessing the fine.
4	(b) Any person who uses a parking space reserved for
5	persons with disabilities and refuses or fails to present an
6	identification card issued under this chapter or the rules
7	adopted thereunder to an enforcement officer upon request shall
8	be guilty of a traffic infraction under chapter 291D and shall
9	be fined no less than \$250 nor more than \$500.
10	(c) Any citation issued under this chapter may be mailed
11	to the violator pursuant to section 291C-165(b).
12	(d) Any person who possesses a valid special license

16	that the	report is legitimate and the violation of subsection
17	(a) is mo	re likely than not to have occurred, the department
18	shall mai	l a notice to the registered owner of the motor
19	vehicle.	The notice shall inform the owner that a vehicle
20	registere	d in the owner's name has been reported by a citizen
21	for viola	ting subsection (a); provided that the notice shall not

1	contain the name of the reporting party. In addition, the		
2	notice shall include the following information:		
3	(1) The date, time, and location of the violation;		
4	(2) The license plate number of the vehicle reported;		
5	(3) An explanation of the conduct prohibited by this		
6	section; and		
7	(4) An explanation of the fines permitted under this		
8	section.		
9	(f) A notice issued pursuant to subsection (e) shall not		
10	be treated as a summons, citation, or other penalty under this		
11	title.		
12	(g) The department of law enforcement shall adopt rules		
13	pursuant to chapter 91, as may be necessary to implement this		
14	section."

Report Title:

DLE; Traffic Violations; Parking for Disabled Persons; Citizen Reporting

Description:

Allows persons entitled to park in disabled parking spaces to report vehicles illegally parked in disabled parking spaces to the Department of Law Enforcement. Upon receipt of a legitimate report, requires the Department to send a notice to the offender informing them of the report and advising them of the law and penalties for illegally parking in a handicapped space.
