A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the Hawaii Symphony
Orchestra provides a significant public service to the State of
Hawaii and makes significant musical contributions to the
artistic and cultural education of the community through its
performances.

6 The legislature further finds that the Hawaii Symphony 7 Orchestra was founded in 1900 to establish and operate a 8 professional symphony orchestra in Hawaii. The symphony hosts 9 shows and programs featuring musicians and performing artists 10 from around the world, in addition to promoting local talent 11 within Hawaii.

12 The legislature recognizes that the State has a certain 13 responsibility to the Hawaii Symphony Orchestra for the public 14 services it provides. The legislature notes that designating 15 the Hawaii Symphony Orchestra as the "State of Hawaii Symphony 16 Orchestra" will enable the Hawaii Symphony Orchestra to 17 regularly obtain state funds to help cover its general operating

1	costs in exchange for other services to the State, to be
2	mutually negotiated.
3	Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to designate the
4	Hawaii Symphony Orchestra as the "State of Hawaii Symphony
5	Orchestra".
6	SECTION 2. Chapter 9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
7	by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
8	read as follows:
9	"§9- Hawaii Symphony Orchestra; designation; funding.
10	(a) The Hawaii Symphony Orchestra shall be designated the State
11	of Hawaii Symphony Orchestra.
12	(b) The qualifying standards and conditions related to the
13	receipt of funds contained in chapter 42F shall not apply to
14	funds received by the State of Hawaii Symphony Orchestra;
15	provided that if the State of Hawaii Symphony Orchestra, in
16	turn, contracts with a recipient or provider, then the
17	qualifying standards, conditions, and other provisions of
18	chapter 42F shall apply to the recipient or provider and the
19	contract.
20	(c) The designation of the Hawaii Symphony Orchestra as
21	the State of Hawaii Symphony Orchestra shall not impinge on the

1	autonomy of the Hawaii Symphony Orchestra, nor imply state
2	control over its programs or policies, except as specifically
3	provided in this section.
4	(d) The comptroller and the legislative auditor shall have
5	the authority to examine the use of state funds and shall report
6	any findings to the legislature.
7	(e) The president and chief executive officer of the
8	Hawaii Symphony Orchestra shall provide an annual report to the
9	legislature no later than twenty days before the legislature
10	convenes each regular session. At a minimum, the annual report
11	shall include an explanation of the operations, maintenance, and
12	other functions accomplished by state fund expenditures in the
13	previous fiscal year."
14	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
15	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$500,000 or so much
16	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and the
17	same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
18	2026-2027 for the general operating costs of the State of Hawaii
19	Symphony Orchestra, including:
20	(1) Operations and maintenance of the organization; and

1	(2) Advice, consultations, and services to state agencies,
2	free of charge, including:
3	(A) Free admission to public school faculty, staff,
4	and students who attend shows through department
5	of education programs; and
6	(B) Setting standards in the symphony's educational
7	programming and public activities.
8	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the state
9	foundation on culture and the arts for the purposes of this Act.
10	SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
11	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
