A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ROYAL MAUSOLEUM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. All rights, powers, functions, and duties of
- 2 the department of land and natural resources regarding the
- 3 stewardship of the Royal Mausoleum, Mauna Ala, are transferred
- 4 to the office of Hawaiian affairs.
- 5 All officers and employees whose functions are transferred
- 6 by this Act shall be transferred with their functions and shall
- 7 continue to perform their regular duties upon their transfer,
- 8 subject to the state personnel laws and this Act.
- 9 No officer or employee of the State having tenure shall
- 10 suffer any loss of salary, seniority, prior service credit,
- 11 vacation, sick leave, or other employee benefit or privilege as
- 12 a consequence of this Act, and such officer or employee may be
- 13 transferred or appointed to a civil service position without the
- 14 necessity of examination; provided that the officer or employee
- 15 possesses the minimum qualifications for the position to which
- 16 transferred or appointed; and provided that subsequent changes

- 1 in status may be made pursuant to applicable civil service and
- 2 compensation laws.
- 3 An officer or employee of the State who does not have
- 4 tenure and who may be transferred or appointed to a civil
- 5 service position as a consequence of this Act shall become a
- 6 civil service employee without the loss of salary, seniority,
- 7 prior service credit, vacation, sick leave, or other employee
- 8 benefits or privileges and without the necessity of examination;
- 9 provided that such officer or employee possesses the minimum
- 10 qualifications for the position to which transferred or
- 11 appointed.
- 12 If an office or position held by an officer or employee
- 13 having tenure is abolished, the officer or employee shall not
- 14 thereby be separated from public employment, but shall remain in
- 15 the employment of the State with the same pay and classification
- 16 and shall be transferred to some other office or position for
- 17 which the officer or employee is eliqible under the personnel
- 18 laws of the State as determined by the head of the department or
- 19 the governor.
- 20 SECTION 2. All appropriations, records, equipment,
- 21 machines, files, supplies, contracts, books, papers, documents,

- 1 maps, and other personal property heretofore made, used,
- 2 acquired, or held by the department of land and natural
- 3 resources relating to the functions transferred to the office of
- 4 Hawaiian affairs shall be transferred with the functions to
- 5 which they relate.
- 6 SECTION 3. All rules, policies, procedures, guidelines,
- 7 and other material adopted or developed by the department of
- 8 land and natural resources to implement provisions of the Hawaii
- 9 Revised Statutes that are made reenacted or applicable to the
- 10 office of Hawaiian affairs by this Act shall remain in full
- 11 force and effect until amended or repealed by the board of land
- 12 and natural resources pursuant to chapter 91, Hawaii Revised
- 13 Statutes.
- In the interim, every reference to the department of land
- 15 and natural resources or the board of land and natural resources
- 16 in those rules, policies, procedures, guidelines, and other
- 17 material is amended to refer to the office of Hawaiian affairs
- 18 and the board of trustees of the office of Hawaiian affairs, as
- 19 appropriate.
- 20 SECTION 4. All deeds, leases, contracts, loans,
- 21 agreements, permits, or other documents executed or entered into

- 1 by or on behalf of the department of land and natural resources,
- 2 pursuant to the provisions of the Hawaii Revised Statutes, that
- 3 are reenacted or made applicable to the office of Hawaiian
- 4 affairs by this Act shall remain in full force and effect. Upon
- 5 effective date of this Act, every reference to the department of
- 6 land and natural resources or the chairperson of the board of
- 7 land and natural resources therein shall be construed as a
- 8 reference to the office of Hawaiian affairs or the chief
- 9 executive officer of the office of Hawaiian affairs, as
- 10 appropriate.
- 11 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
