### A BILL FOR AN ACT

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 91-2.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 "(a) Beginning January 1, 2000, all state agencies, through the office of the lieutenant governor, shall make 4 5 available on the website of the office of the lieutenant 6 governor each proposed rulemaking action of the agency and the 7 full text of the agency's proposed rules or changes to existing 8 The full text of the agency's proposed rules shall be in rules. a digitally accessible and searchable format. The internet 9 website shall provide instructions regarding how to download the 10 11 information regarding proposed rulemaking actions and the full 12 text of the agency's proposed rules." Section 91-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 13 SECTION 2. 14 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 15 "(a) Each agency adopting, amending, or repealing a rule, upon approval [thereof] by the governor or the mayor of the 16 17 county, shall file [forthwith] certified copies [thereof] of the



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1 rules with the lieutenant governor in the case of the State, or 2 with the clerk of the county in the case of a county. In 3 addition, the clerks of all of the counties shall file [forthwith] certified copies [thereof] of the rules with the 4 lieutenant governor. A permanent register of the rules, open to 5 public inspection, shall be kept by the lieutenant governor and 6 7 the clerks of the counties. All state agencies, through the office of the lieutenant governor, shall make available on the 8 9 website of the office of the lieutenant governor the full text of the rules of the agency in a digitally accessible and 10 11 searchable format." 12 SECTION 3.
