The purpose of this measure is to request the Department of Transportation, Department of Education, and Department of Transportation of the County of Maui to collaborate to propose viable solutions to improve pedestrian and traffic safety and relieve traffic congestion around Haiku Elementary School.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from two individuals. Your Committee received comments on this measure from the Department of Education.

Your Committee finds that traffic congestion and safety concerns around Haiku Elementary School have become a growing issue, particularly during school drop-off and pick-up times. Your Committee further finds that parents, teachers, and community members have raised concerns about pedestrian safety, the need for
