"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO SKILLS-BASED HIRING,"

The purpose of this measure is to prohibit the State, including its departments, agencies, or political subdivisions, from requiring a bachelor's degree as a qualification for a state or county position, unless the knowledge and skills required to perform job duties can only be obtained through the culmination of coursework in a bachelor's degree program.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Department of Accounting and General Services; Hawai'i State Council on Developmental Disabilities; Grassroot Institute of Hawaii; and three individuals. Your Committee received comments on this measure from the Department of Budget and Finance and Department of Human Resources Development.


