RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

Repeals all permissible uses of consumer fireworks and makes conforming amendments to the Fireworks Control Law. Establishes civil penalties for the use and sale of consumer fireworks, including nuisance abatement proceedings and forfeiture of assets used in the commission of the illegal use or sale of consumer fireworks. Establishes the Firework Forfeiture Special Fund to deposit asset forfeiture proceeds and to provide for community safety education programs. PSM/CPN, WAM/JDC
