SB 444 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO STATE GOVERNMENT.  Authorizes boards and commissions to make employment decisions related to its officers and employees without the approval of the head of the department to which the board or commission is administratively attached.	GVO/LBT, WAM
Status & Testimony	RELATING TO REMOTE WORK ASSESSMENTS. Requires the Comptroller to periodically assess telework-eligible positions and notify all eligible employees of their eligibility to telework. Requires the Department of Human Resources Development and Office of Enterprise Technology Services to assist.	GVO/LBT, WAM
SB 1057 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.  Clarifies that the bid incentive given to bidders for public works construction projects who are parties to an apprenticeship agreement is based on apprenticeable trades utilized, rather than employed, to construct the public works.	LBT/GVO, WAM

Status & Testimony

#### RELATING TO SKILLS-BASED HIRING.

Prohibits the State or any of its departments, agencies, or political subdivisions from requiring a bachelor's degree as a condition of eligibility for hire to a position in state employment. Establishes exemptions.
