<a href="#">SB 338</a> <a href="#">Status &amp; Testimony</a>	RELATING TO TAXATION. For taxable years beginning after December 31, 2025, temporarily reinstates the Technology Infrastructure Renovation Tax Credit and expands the definition of "technology-enabled infrastructure" to include data servers.	LBT, WAM
<a href="#">SB 1491</a> <a href="#">Status &amp; Testimony</a>	RELATING TO DEPARTMENTAL DATA SHARING. Adds the Department of Taxation to the list of state agencies sharing data through the statewide longitudinal data system. Allows the Department of Taxation to provide the University of Hawaii and other state agencies certain wage data.	LBT, WAM
<a href="#">SB 1156</a> <a href="#">Status &amp; Testimony</a>	RELATING TO DEEPFAKES. Establishes the crime of unlawful creation or distribution of a sexually explicit deepfake.	LBT, JDC
<a href="#">SB 853</a> <a href="#">Status &amp; Testimony</a>	RELATING TO IMMIGRATION. Establishes the Immigration Services Trust Fund to support immigration-related matters within the Office of Community Services. Requires the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations to submit annual reports to the Legislature on the accounting of expenditures of the Fund. Appropriates funds.	LBT, WAM
<a href="#">SB 436</a> <a href="#">Status &amp; Testimony</a>	RELATING TO THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL. Provides that no person shall serve as State Fire Marshal for more than 3 terms.	LBT, WAM

Requires employers in the food service industry to allow their employees an unpaid rest period of 30 consecutive minutes for each five consecutive hours of working time. Effective 1/1/2026.

- Testifiers for this hearing will be limited to **2 minutes** each.
