My name is Christopher Fernandez, and I am the Executive Officer of the Board of Psychology (Board). The Board supports the confirmation of Dr. Steven Taketa's appointment to the Board as a licensed member.

Dr. Taketa has nearly 20 years of experience in psychology obtaining Hawaii licensure in 2012.
