### **TESTIMONY IN SUPPORT OF SCR148/SR119**

The Military and Community Relations Office (MACRO) of the Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism (DBEDT) strongly supports the construction of a floating drydock at Pearl Harbor.

The construction of a new floating drydock at Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard increases the shipyard's capacity to service submarines and surface vessels, bolstering national defense while also driving substantial economic benefits for Hawaii.

Chair Elefante, Vice Chair Wakai, and Members of the Committee:

The Hawaii Military Affairs Council ("MAC") **supports** SCR 148 / SR 119 which supports the construction of a floating drydock at Pearl Harbor.

The MAC was established in 1985 when the Chamber was appointed by the State to serve as the liaison to the military. The MAC advocates on behalf of Hawaii's military, and is comprised of business leaders, academic institutions, State and County officials, members of the CODEL, community leaders, labor unions and organizations and retired U.S. flag and general officers. The MAC works to support Hawaii's location as a strategic U.S. headquarters in the Indo-Asia-Pacific region which is crucial for U.S. national and homeland security.

The construction of Drydock 5, valued at over \$2.2 billion, is the largest public works project in the history of Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard (PHNSY) and is critically needed to repair and maintain the Virginia class submarines. The Navy identified the need for a floating drydock at PHNSY to ensure there is no pause or impinging on the equally important repair and maintenance work of the Surface fleet. This collective capability is critical to our nation's ability to ensure a free and open Indo-Pacific region.

PHNSY is the largest industrial employer in the State of Hawaii with more than 6,500 Hawaii civilian employees. By supporting this resolution, we advocate for PHNSY's ability to ensure that the fleet is fit to fight tonight, keeping maritime lanes open in and about the South China Sea against China, our near peer adversary in this most consequential region.
