

ACT 57

A Bill for an Act to Amend Act 30 of the Session Laws of Hawaii 1962 and Act 201, Session Laws of Hawaii 1963 Relating to Appropriations for Public Improvements.

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. The unrequired balance of \$72,200 in Item C-2-d, section 1, Act 30, Session Laws of Hawaii 1962, "Honokawai Park, Maui, Land Acquisition for State Park" and the unallotted balance of \$19,577.74 in Item C-1-c, section 1, Act 201, Session Laws of Hawaii 1963, "Kau-manahina (sic) Park, Construction of Shelter Cabins" shall be used to develop a State Park at Waianapanapa Caves, Maui. The funds are to be used, to include but not limited to, for the following purposes; to acquire land if necessary and to plan and construct necessary roads, parking, landscaping, structures and sanitary facilities and the installation of utilities.

SECTION 2. Appropriate accommodations, facilities and services for public use and enjoyment are to be undertaken by concession agreement, if at all possible, in accordance with the intent of Act 163, Session Laws of Hawaii 1963, the State Resort Facility Act.

SECTION 3. The unexpended balance of \$40,000 in Item D-9-i, section 1, Act 30, Session Laws of Hawaii 1962, "Road to connect Nalani

Street to Ainalako Road, Construct road over State property, abutting properties bearing Tax Key numbers 2-4-04-85, 2-4-04-86 and 2-4-04-87", shall be used to construct a road to connect Laua Street to Ainalako Road, over State property, abutting properties bearing Tax Key numbers 2-4-04-85, 2-4-04-86 and 2-4-04-87.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
