ACT 170

A Bill for an Act Relating to Public Employment of Non-Residents and Amending Chapter 5, Revised Laws of Hawaii 1955, as Amended.

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. Subsection (b) of Section 5-1, Revised Laws of

Hawaii 1955, as amended, is hereby further amended to read:

"(b) For the purpose of obtaining services which are essential to the public interest for which no competent person with the foregoing qualifications applies within 45 days after the first publication of an advertisement of such position or a notice of an examination therefor, which advertisement or notice shall have been published more than once, and not oftener than once a week, in a newspaper of general circulation in the State, a person without such qualifications may, upon prior certification by the State Director of Personnel Services or the City and County Director of Civil Service or the County Personnel Director, whichever is applicable, and with the approval of the Chief Executive Officer for the State or the political subdivision concerned, be employed:

(1) under a contract not to exceed 2 years when the services have been exempted from the provisions of the Civil Service and/or Compensation Laws as set forth in the Revised Laws of Hawaii 1955, as amended, or in the county charters, whichever is applicable; or

(2) under a probationary appointment of 1 year when such employment is subject to the provisions of the Civil Service Laws as set forth in the Revised Laws of Hawaii 1955, as amended, or in the county charters whichever is applicable; provided that, such appointee shall have met the requirements, except for residency, as set forth in the laws aforementioned, including the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder.

SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. (Approved June 22, 1965.) H.B. 793.
