ACT 155

A Bill for an Act Relating to Elections.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. Section 11-76, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

"(a) Electronic ballot and voting machine elections. Precinct officials, other than the chairman and voter assistance official, shall be paid [\$60] <u>\$75</u> for each election. The voter assistance official shall be paid [\$65] <u>\$80</u> for each election. The [chairman] <u>chairperson</u> of the precinct officials for each precinct shall be paid [\$70] <u>\$85</u> for each election for a single-unit precinct and [\$10] <u>\$15</u> more per unit for larger precincts. Alternate precinct officials who are trained and certified and who remain available but [who are not placed for] <u>do not</u> work in either the primary or general election shall be compensated \$5."

SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$108,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 1990-1991, to increase the compensation of precinct officials.

SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of the lieutenant governor for the purposes of this Act.

SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 1989.
