H.B. NO. 1188

A Bill for an Act Relating to Juvenile Justice.

*Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Hawaii:*

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to amend section 571D-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, by increasing the membership of the juvenile justice interagency board.

SECTION 2. Section 571D-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:

**“§571D-1 Juvenile justice interagency board.** There is established within the department of the attorney general for administrative purposes the juvenile justice interagency board, consisting of [eleven] thirteen voting members which shall include a police chief of one of the counties, the prosecuting attorney of a county, [a representative] two representatives from a private social service [agency,] agencies, and two additional members, all appointed by the governor as provided in section 26-34, and the superintendent of education, the public defender, the direction<sup>1</sup> of the Center for Youth Research at the University of Hawaii, the director of corrections, the director of health, the director of human services, and the senior judge of the first circuit family court as ex officio members. The composition of the board shall include a resident member from each county in the State.

## **ACT 183**

The attorney general shall designate the executive secretary of the board.”

SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
