S.B. NO. 107

A Bill for an Act Relating to Declaration of National Emergency.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to replace obsolete military titles in section 134-34, Hawaii Revised Statutes, without changing the intent of the existing section.

SECTION 2. Section 134-34, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:

"§134-34 National emergency, when. A national emergency or crisis shall be deemed to have arisen when the governor[, the commanding general of the United States Army, Pacific, and the commandant of the 14th Naval District and Hawaiian Sea Frontier] and the senior United States military commander head-quartered in the State or, in the absence of the commander, a duly designated representative have, in the exercise of their discretion, so determined."

SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. (Approved June 8, 1989.)
