A Bill for an Act Relating to Ordinary Disability Retirement Under the Employees' Retirement System.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. Section 88-76, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:

"\$88-76 Allowance on ordinary disability retirement. Upon retirement for ordinary disability, a [member shall receive a service retirement allowance if the member has attained the age of fifty-five years, otherwise, the] member shall receive a retirement allowance of one and three-fourths per cent of the member's average final compensation for each full year of credited service; except that for each year of credited service as judge, an elective officer, or the chief clerk, assistant clerk, sergeant at arms, or assistant sergeant at arms of [both houses] a house of the legislature, the member shall receive a retirement allowance computed as provided in section 88-74(3)(A). The minimum retirement allowance payable under this section shall be [an allowance of] thirty per cent of the member's average final compensation."
