A Bill for an Act Relating to Naturopathy.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. Section 455-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:

“§455-3 Qualifications of applicants. Each applicant shall be a graduate of a school, university, or college of naturopathy that¹ has received candidacy status with, or has been accredited by, a regional or a national professional accrediting body [either of which shall have been] recognized by the United States Department of Education].: provided that any applicant who graduated from a college of naturopathy prior to 1987 shall be deemed qualified if the college was approved by the board prior to 1987 and has been accredited by a regional or national professional accrediting body recognized by the United States Department of Education.”

SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
