

SECOND DAY**Tuesday, August 23, 2022**

The Senate of the Thirty-First Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Second Special Session of 2022, convened at 11:04 a.m. with the Vice President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present, with the exception of Senators Keohokalole, Kim, Kouchi, and Misalucha who were excused.

The Vice President announced that she had read and approved the Journal of the First Day.

At this time, Senator Rhoads noted the presence of the Honorable Mark E. Recktenwald, Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, State of Hawai'i; and Rod Maile, administrative director of the courts, who were seated in the audience.

ORDER OF THE DAY**ADVISE AND CONSENT**

Stand. Com. Rep. No. 1 (Jud. Com. No. 1):

Senator Rhoads moved that Stand. Com. Rep. No. 1 be received and placed on file, seconded by Senator Acasio and carried.

Senator Rhoads then moved that the Senate consent to the appointment of ANNALISA M. BERNARD as Judge of the District Court of the Second Circuit, for a term of six years (name amended to ANNALISA M. BERNARD LEE by Jud. Com. No. 2), seconded by Senator Acasio.
